



CANTHACUR POST TREATMENT CARE

After care instruction post Canthacur/Catharidin application:

1. If there is any irritation, burning or discomfort in the area treated sooner than the time instructed to wash off the blister, the area should be washed with soap and water immediately.
2. 24-48 hours after treatment: Blisters have usually formed. Try not to manipulate the blister, if necessary, cover the area with a bandage. The blister should heal in approximately one week.
3. 3-4 days after treatment: The crusted blister should fall off leaving superficial abrasions.
4. If you are instructed to use any topical medication at home please wait 3-4 days after the initial in-office treatment before applying the topical medication.
5. The area will likely need to be treated more than once. Please schedule a follow-up visit for 3-4 weeks.
You may use Tylenol if there is mild/moderate pain
